TRANSFER APPLICATION GUIDE | FALL 2020

ADMISSIONS PROCESS

Admission to Cal State Fullerton is a highly competitive process. As an impacted campus, there are more qualified applications than we can accommodate. To ensure a fair process for all applicants, the GPA threshold will not be determined until after November 30, 2019.

All the deadlines listed below are strictly enforced.

If a deadline is missed, your admissions may be rescinded.

1 APPLY

- OCTOBER 1, 2019 - NOVEMBER 30, 2019 | CAL STATE APPLY**
Apply online at calstate.edu/apply for Fall 2020 admissions.
Deadline is November 30, 2019.
- OCTOBER 1, 2019 - MARCH 2, 2020 | FINANCIAL AID**
Apply at fafsa.gov for financial aid for the 2020-21 academic year. For the California Dream Act Application visit dream.csac.ca.gov. Any student interested in being considered for financial assistance for the 2020-21 academic year must apply by **March 2, 2020.**

Regularly check your student portal and CSUF email through my.fullerton.edu for any communication regarding your status. You must clear any “hold” or “to do” items listed under the student center.

TRANSFER

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

Apply as soon as possible. The filing period for Fall 2020 admission is from **October 1, 2019 - November 30, 2019**. Apply online at calstate.edu/apply. Check your admission status at my.fullerton.edu.

Cal State Fullerton only accepts upper-division transfer students.

Students must meet all of the following requirements for admission to CSUF:

- Good academic standing at the last college or university attended
- 60 transferrable semester units (90 quarter units); a maximum of 70 transferrable units from a community college or another institution may be used towards completion of a degree
- A minimum of 30-semester units (45 quarter units) in CSU-approved general education coursework with grades of C- or higher, selected from either the CSU General Education Breadth pattern or the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC), including completion of the "Golden Four" courses.

GOLDEN FOUR COURSES

1. Oral Communication
2. Written Communication
3. Critical Thinking
4. Mathematics/Quantitative Reasoning

IMPACTION

Cal State Fullerton is a fully impacted campus. Impaction means there are more applicants for our campus than can be accommodated. To ensure capacity is not exceeded, more rigorous standards are applied to the transfer applicant pool. Impacted criteria may include local vs. out-of-local and/or major program impaction.

All transfer students must declare a major when submitting their application.

PLEASE NOTE: After submitting your application, you will receive an email that contains your **Campus Wide ID (CWID)** number and login instructions to my.fullerton.edu. Please activate and regularly check your student portal and CSUF email for updates on your admissions status.

SPRING APPLICANTS

Spring admissions is not always guaranteed to be open. Please check with our office in the summer to see if our campus will accept applicants for the spring.

TUITION & FEES

Undergraduate fees pers semester as of Fall 2019:

- CA Residents: more than 6 units = \$3,447*
- CA Residents: 6 units or less = \$2,241*
- Non-CA Residents = \$3,447 + \$396 per unit
